Social & Behavioral Science

Upon successful completion of the general education requirements and the suggested program requirements for an Associate Degree the student shall:

- 1. Define the basic core areas of the social sciences.
- 2. Interpret the primary structure of the U.S. from a historical, governmental, psychological or sociological perspective in terms of global culture and diverse society.
- 3. Recognize some aspects of the differing disciplines in the social sciences to the analysis of current events in the news.
- 4. Explore the relationship of the individual and the greater society from a historical, governmental, psychological or sociological perspective as it affects personal behavior, social development and quality of life of the individual, family and community.
- 5. Recognize and compare political, geographical, social, cultural, religious and intellectual institutions, structures, and processes across a range of historical periods and cultures.
- 6. Recognize the contributions of past cultures/societies to the contemporary world and think critically about how individuals are influenced by them.
